LAMANA INSTRUCTION



HAT #07/10

SIZE M (54–57 cm)

MATERIALS Lamana Como (100% Merino Superfine, approx. 120 m/25 g) 25 g in color Slate Grey shade 28M, 50 g in color Aubergine shade 50, 4 mm knitting needles (UK 8/US 6), 4 stitch markers, tapestry needle

PATTERN NOTE Main pattern: half brioche stitch:

Row 1 (RS): selvedge st , *k 1, p 1, rep from * to last 2 sts, k 1, s


Row 2 (WS): s, *yf sl1 yo, k 1, rep from * to last 2 sts, yf sl1 yo, s

Row 3 (RS): s, *k 1 tog with yo, p 1, rep from * to last 2 sts, k 1 tog with yo, s. Repeat rows 2 and 3 for pattern. Tension/gauge: 23 sts and 50 rows in main pattern = 10 x 10 cm

HOW TO CO 105 sts with Slate Grey and work in main pattern for 4 cm. Change to Aubergine and continue in pattern for further 16 cm. In following RS count 13 sts (including selvedge st), place marker on following st and then on every 26th st 3 more times (all marked sts are k sts) and work decreases as follows: *work in pattern to 1 st before marked st, slip 2 sts knitwise, k 1, then pass slipped sts over (2 sts decreased, the marked st is on top of the decreased sts), rep from * 3 more times. In following WS row p each marked st (without yo), work all other sts in pattern. Decrease as given every second RS row for 8 more times (= 33 sts left). In next RS row work as follows: s, *k2tog tbl, rep from * to last st, s. Purl following WS row, then cut yarn leaving a long tail, thread through rem sts and secure.

TO FINISH Close back seam, weave in ends. If you wish to turn up the brim (see picture) sew first 8 cm on RS of work. Cover with a damp cloth and leave until dry.

rep = repeat
k2tog = knit 2 sts together
tbl= through back loop
rem = remaining
