



### PONCHO #06/07

**SIZE** One size, approx. 75 × 55 cm

Ⓐ

**MATERIALS** Lamana Como (100% Merino Superfine, approx. 120 m/25 g) 225 g in colour Pearl Grey shade 37, 4 mm knitting needles, (for double stranded quick-knit version: 300 g in colour Anthracite shade 04M, w6 mm knitting needles), tapestry needle

**PATTERN NOTE** Border Pattern: Moss stitch

Row 1 (RS): \*k1, p1, rep from \* to end of row

Row 2 (WS): work sts as they appear

Row 3 (RS): \*p1, k1, rep from \* to end of row

Row 4 (WS): work sts as they appear. Repeat rows 1–4 for pattern.

Main Pattern: stocking stitch: knit RS rows, purl WS rows

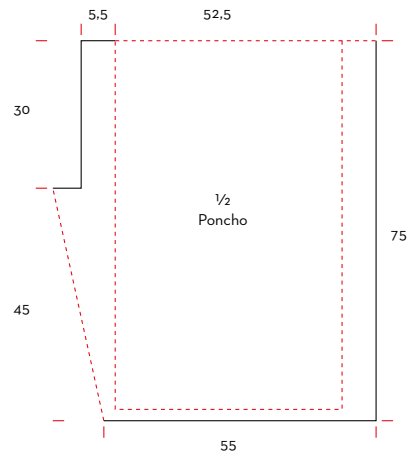
Gauge: 20 sts and 26 rows in stocking st with 4 mm needles = 10 × 10 cm (double stranded alternative: 14 sts and 22 rows with 2 strands of yarn held together and 6 mm needles = 10 × 10 cm)

**HOW TO:** CO 223 sts (155) using 4 mm (6 mm) needles and work in moss st for 20 (10) rows. In next RS row divide sts as follows: 11 sts (7) in moss st, 95 sts (67) in stocking st, 11 sts (7) in moss st (= centre sts), 95 sts (67) in stocking st, 11 sts (7) in moss st. Continue in pattern as established and, at the same time, increase every 12th (10th) row 1 st each before and after centre sts 11 (9) times, work increased sts in moss st [= 33 (25) centre sts]. When work measures 45 cm from cast-on edge, BO centre 11 sts and continue both halves separately in established pattern for further 30 cm. With the two parts right side together work a 3-needle BO starting from the outer edge until last 11 sts (7). BO last 11 sts (7) separately in moss st.

**TO FINISH** Weave in ends. Cover with a damp cloth and leave until dry.
