## LAMANA INSTRUCTION



#### **HAT #06/16**

SIZE M (54–57 cm)

**MATERIALS** Lamana Nazca (40% Alpaca, 40% Merino Wool, 20% Polyamide, approx. 50 m/50 g) 100 g in colour Antique Pink shade 40,

6 mm and 8 mm knitting needles, tapestry needle

**PATTERN NOTE** Rib pattern: RS rows: k2, p2; WS rows: work sts as they appear

Main pattern: Row 1 (RS): selvedge st, \*k1, p1, repeat from \*, end with selvedge st

Row 2 (WS): work sts as they appear

Row 3 (RS): selvedge st, \*p1, k1, rep from \*, end with selvedge st

Row 4 (WS): work sts as they appear. Rep rows 1-4

Gauge: 14 sts and 20 rows in main pattern with 8 mm needles = 10  $\times$  10 cm

**HOW TO** Cast on 82 sts using 6 mm needles and work 12 rows in rib pattern. Change to 8 mm needles and work 26 rows in main pattern. In following RS row purl tog the 3rd and 4th st after selvedge st, then always purl tog every 5th and 6th st (= 69 sts remain). Repeat these decreases in next 4 RS rows at the same places and work sts between decs in pattern (in each dec row you have 1 st less between decs and 13 sts less per row) until 17 sts remain. Cut yarn leaving a long tail. Thread through remaining sts and pull tight.

**TO FINISH** Weave in ends and close back seam. Cover with a damp cloth and leave until dry.
