

SHAWL #E05

SIZE Width approx. 200 cm/78.7", height approx. 60 cm/23.6"

MATERIALS Lamana Premia (60% Super Kid Mohair, 40% Silk, approx. 300 m/25 g) 50 g in color Basalt Blue shade 46, 5 mm (US 8/UK 6) knitting needles, 1 tapestry needle

ABOUT The explanations of the abbreviations used in this pattern can be found on ast page

PATTERN NOTE Main pattern: garter stitch: knit all sts in RS rows and WS rows

Lace pattern: see "How to" section

Gauge/Tension: 13 sts and 26 rows, double stranded (2 strands of yarn held together),

in main pattern = $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}/4$ " square

HOW TO This shawl in the shape of a flat V is worked double stranded throughout the pattern and starts at the top in the middle. CO 5 sts, mark the center st and k the WS row.

*Next RS row: CO 2 sts at beg of row and k these 2 sts, then k to center st, yo, k 1 (= center st), yo, k to end of row; WS: CO 2 sts at beg of row and k these 2 sts, then k to center st (also k the yo), p 1 (= center st), k the yo and k all following sts to end of row. Rep from * (per RS row: 4 increases, per WS row: 2 increases) until 8 rows are worked (= 4 ridges, 29 sts in total).


In next RS row work a lace pattern row as follows: CO 2 sts and k these 2 sts, *k2tog, yo, rep from * to 2 sts before center st, k 2, yo, k 1 (= center st), yo, k 2, *yo, k2tog, rep from *to end of the row. Work the WS row as established (= 35 sts in total; 6 holes on both sides of the center strip). Continue working in main pattern, as established, for another 6 rows (3 ridges; = 53 sts in total), subsequently work another lace pattern row and corresponding WS row as described above.

Continue working alternately in main pattern and lace pattern, work the lace pattern row every 6-10 rows (3-5 ridges) at will -2 lace pattern rows can also be worked directly one after the other.

When the desired size is reached or the yarn is almost used up, work a stretchy BO as follows: do not work

any inc's in the next RS row, p 1(!) instead, *yo, p 1, then, using the left needle tip, first pass the yo over the last worked st, then pass the first st over the last worked st, rep from * until all sts are bound off.

TO FINISH Weave in all ends. Carefully stretch the shawl and leave to dry under damp clothes.
