



TURTLENECK DICKIE #E06

SIZE Neck circumference 54 cm/21.3", Length turtleneck 22 cm/8.7", total length 60 cm/23.6" (A)

MATERIALS Lamana Bergamo (75% Merino Superfine, 25% Baby Alpaca, approx. 65 m/25 g) 75 g in color Pine shade 34, 4.5 mm (US 7/UK 7) knitting needles, 1 tapestry needle

ABOUT The explanations of the abbreviations used in this pattern can be found on last page

PATTERN NOTE Main pattern: RS: work in 2/2 rib (k 2/p 2), end with k 2; WS: work sts as they appear
Gauge/Tension: 20 sts and 25 rows in main pattern (unstretched) = 10 × 10 cm/4" square
(Please adjust needle size if necessary to obtain correct gauge)

HOW TO The turtleneck dickie is worked top-down and flat, in RS and WS rows.
CO 106 sts and work in main pattern for 22 cm/8.7". BO the first 20 sts in next 2 rows, continue in main pattern over the rem 66 sts and, at the same time, work dec's as follows: k 2, sl1-k1-pss0, work in main pattern to last 4 sts, k2tog, k 2. Rep these dec's every following RS row until 36 sts remain. In next RS row BO all sts in pattern.

TO FINISH Close back seam of turtleneck. Weave in all ends. Leave the turtleneck dickie to dry under a damp cloth.

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ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit

p = purl

st(s) = stitch(es)

RS = right side

WS = wrong side

CO = cast on

BO = bind off

rem = remaining

dec's = decreases

sl1-k1-*psso* = slip 1 stitch, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over (= 1 st decreased)

k2tog = knit 2 sts together (= 1 st decreased)

rep = repeat
